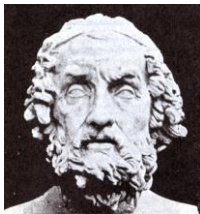




## ***The Journey to “Ithaka”*** ***From Homer to Cavafy and Beyond***
